### School Supplies List

- Personal medication for colds/flu/allergy/cough-Give to Resident Supervisor
- Stereo (optional)-No secular/ burned CD's, school plays Christian music on FM station
- Alarm Clock

\*All dorm rooms are furnished with 2 twin (some extra long twin) beds, dressers, a desk and chair, and closet space. If you are planning on bringing furniture, please call the dean of students first as space is limited. We do allow each room to have one microwave (\$25/yr fee) and one refrigerator (\$25/yr fee). Due to an older electrical system, we **cannot** have coffee makers, ceiling fans and other appliances that may over-load the system. One power strip (with switch and internal breaker) per room is allowed.

\*\*We encourage students to leave their ipods, video games, and other electronic devices at home. If they choose to bring them to school for the ride here, they must be turned into the resident supervisor. All such electronics will be confiscated if they are found/used in the dorms and a reasonable attempt will be made to return them at the end of the year. *Laptops may only be used for school work and any abuse of that privilege can lead to the laptop being confiscated for the remainder of the school year.*
